4. Enrollment

Enrollment numbers are increasing. Currently there are 3,193 students enrolled in
Physics courses, this is a 13% change from last year. Many of the introductory courses are
full. There are waiting lists for most of the introductory courses but we anticipate that
most students will be served (or could be served by opening at times that are not ideal
for the student).

5. Faculty Lounge

 The remodel of the faculty lounge is moving forward. The lounge will be in room 5294 Chamberlin Hall.

6. Matters Arising

- New department computing staff Jes Tikalsky and recently hired Chad Seys were introduced.
- The Board of Visitors meeting will be held on September 21, 2012 at the WID.
- Hiring update: Justine Vandenbroucke has been hired as an assistant professor in Experimental Neutrino and Astroparticle physics. He will be on leave for 2012-13 academic year. Yang Bai has been hired as an assistant professor in Theoretical high energy physics. An offer from Plasma Theory was made to Hanto Ji. He has declined the offer. A hiring request has been made to the dean's office: to continue the plasma search and for two additional entry-level positions.
- The critical compensation fund will make it possible for faculty to get a raise. The University has established eligibility requirements and will provide a list of the people that are up for review. 18 people will be reviewed this fall. One third more will be reviewed in the spring, and the remaining one-third in the fall.
