GERMAN SCIENTIST COMING.

Professor A. Sommerfeld to Give Courses in Wisconsin University.

MADISON, Wis., Aug. 5.—Professor A. Sommerfeld, Professor of Mathematical Physics at the University of Munich, will be in residence at the University of Wisconsin for the first semester of the coming academic year, 1922-23, holding the Karl Schurz Memorial Professorship for that period. Professor Sommerfeld is expected to give a course on atomic structure, and a second course either on the analysis of wave propagation or in the general theory of relativity.

The Karl Schurz Memorial Professorship was founded in 1910 as an exchange professorship with the German universities. The appointment of Professor Sommerfeld marks its resumption after the interruption caused by the war.
